SUMMER SCHOOL RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ALL STUDENTS

1. Summer school will be at East Hartford High School, 869 Forbes Street, East Hartford, CT 06118. Registration will take place at the High School in Room 133 from Tuesday, June 22 to Friday, June 25 (10 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.)
2. Tuition for out-of-district students is \$120 per .5 credit class and must be paid by the first day of summer school. Exceptions must be approved by the Principal or his designee. Credit will not be given until tuition is paid in full.
3. Summer school session begins June 28 and ends July 30, 2010. First Period is from 7:30 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. Second Session is from 10:05 A.M. – 12:35 P.M. All summer school students must report at 7:30 A.M. on June 28, 2010, for pre-admission session.
4. Students must have at least a final average between 50-59 in the course failed during the regular school year to qualify for summer school.
5. Attendance is required at all sessions. More than ONE absence per semester (for any reason) will result in your immediate dismissal from the Summer School Program, course failure, and no refund of tuition. Three tardies are equivalent to one absence. (A tardy is defined as no more than 10 minutes late for a session .) Leaving early is also considered an absence.
6. Students may not enroll after completion of the first day of summer school, unless previous arrangements have been made with the Principal.
7. Transportation is the responsibility of the student and/or the student's parents.
8. Students will supply their own notebooks, pencils, and other supplies.
9. Students enrolled in two classes are not permitted to leave the building between classes without authorization.
10. Summer school grades will be forwarded to student's home school upon completion of the course and full payment of tuition.
11. Students will park in the student parking lot (east side of building adjacent to pool entrance).
12. Entrance and exit will be at the pool and library entrances only.
13. Classes will only be offered if there is sufficient enrollment and/or an instructor is available.
14. Students will only be permitted in the assigned classroom and lavatory on the same floor—not in any other area of the building, unless escorted by the teacher.
15. Any misconduct on or within the school property regarding littering, excessive noise or vehicle code or city violations will result in student dismissal and/or appropriate fines.
16. Discipline problems of any kind will not be tolerated. Students will be dismissed from school with no refund of money and no course credit.
17. Students will not be refunded any fees paid to the East Hartford School District Summer School Program for voluntary or involuntary withdrawal reasons.
18. Hats, sunglasses, clothing considered to be revealing and/or inappropriate, as well as any items of clothing which sponsor, promote, or advertise tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and/or contain sexual innuendo will not be permitted in the building. Hats may not be worn in the building.
19. Use or possession of tobacco products is prohibited in the school building and on school grounds including all roadways and parking lots. Violators will be withdrawn from the summer school program.
20. Students are not refunded any fees or costs paid to the East Hartford School District Summer School Program for the following withdrawal reasons:
 - A. Absences
 - B. Discipline
 - C. Failure to comply with any school regulations
21. Students should not schedule doctor, dentist, or any other appointments during summer school class time. This will count as an absence if a student leaves early or arrives late.
22. Please note the first day of Summer School is Monday, June 28, 2010.
23. East Hartford residents may be required to provide proof of residence and/or Student ID #.
24. Passes must be used during class time in hallways.
25. The Summer School Office will be located in Room 133.
