



Students log in by typing a 6-character code.

Recommended for students with their own Google accounts.



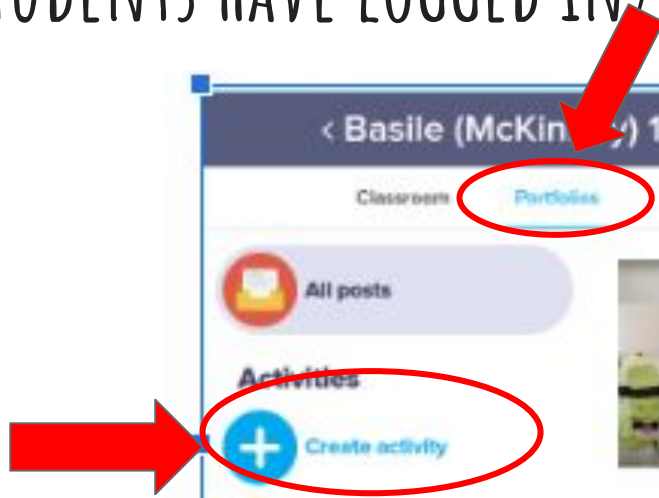

1. Open ClassDojo app or website: [dojo.me](https://dojo.me)
2. Click "Enter Text Code", OR tap "I'm a student" on the app
3. Enter the text code to sign in
