#### East Hartford Public Schools Legislative Priorities

#### Nathan Quesnel, Superintendent of Schools

Superintendent Quesnel presented the framework for EHPS' policy positions that we ask our legislative delegates to consider in their policy development and advocacy during the 2021 Legislative Session. Funding priorities include: Implement the ECS Phase in Formula (2028), fully fund the 7% Magnet Cap Language, and maintain current Grants. The Policy priority focuses on providing Mandate Relief/Unfunded Mandates.

Mr. Whittaker gave a detailed presentation on recent RFP/ Service contract awards for the first half of 2021 RFP results in the first half of 2021 include: Design Services- EHHS Replacement of existing Tri-Gen Plant and Associates Absorber (RFP #1770-20), Athletic Trainer Services (RFP #1773-20) and Information Technology Contracted Services (RFP #1774-20).

#### **Capital Plan Presentation**

#### Benjamin Whittaker, Chief Operations Officer

Mr. Whittaker presented the 5-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) that covers FY2022 through FY2026. The entire CIP can be viewed on the EHPS website which includes details for each of the

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(61) projects in the plan. The FY22-26 CIP includes all major infrastructure improvements and capital asset purchases across the entire district, not just Facilities. For example, Information Technology (IT) now has (10) projects included in the plan, and the Fine Arts Department is the first instructional department to include projects in the plan. This integration will ensure major purchases are planned, scoped, estimated, and tracked well in advance of anticipated funding. Mr. aucailor Whittaker noted that this plan is very much a "living" document, and priorities will change as situations or funding sources dictate.
