Third Quarter Financial Update

Mr. Whittaker gave a detailed third quarter financial update. The update included the 2021 yearend forecast of \$92,264,375 which reflects a -0.4% variance. Some points to note are decreased expenses due the pandemic such as less mileage, fewer conferences, less bussing, school closures, lower water consumption and a decreased need for substitutes.

Principal Ryan presented the results of East Hartford High School's Advanced Placement Program, East Hartford High School's AP Program is an open enrollment program.
