- c. <u>Updated Appendix "A" Pricing Sheet:</u> Attached to this addendum also includes a new section: Add/Alternative for Additional Top Soil.

Question and Answers:

1. Question: What is the budget for this project?

Answer: Construction Budget is \$200,000

2. Question: Will a town or school owned area be designated for dumping of organic material/ excess soil at no cost to contractor?

Answer: No, the contractor will cover costs for removal of any organic materials from the site.

3. Question: Is there a working irrigation system on site? If not, where is the water source located, and who is responsible for watering daily?

Answer: There is no irrigation system, however there is a water source located at the adjacent baseball field where the contractor can use to provide their own portable irrigation for the field to establish the grass up to the time of the 1st mowing, the owner will then take responsibility.

4. Question: What is the grow in period contractor is responsible for maintenance?

Answer: Grass will be fully established during the fall of 2024, the field will not be used for fall sports.

5. Question: How long will the field be closed for use after the project is completed?

Answer: Closed for school sports until Spring 2025

6. Question: Have you considered installing sod instead of hydroseed?

Answer: No, hydroseed is specified.

7. Question: The Plans seem vague in some areas. Please let us know what depth the entire field/ needs to be stripped and the depths of new material to be installed – at what depth does the infield clay need to be

Answer: The exact quantity of unsuitable soil will not be confirmed until excavation is done, but contractor should carry the proper amount for the project. For any additional amounts over base needed as identified after excavation, bidders should submit the updated Appendix "A" Price Sheet included in this addendum (along with their bid packet) which lists the add/alt. for pricing addition top soil.

8. Question: Test pit 204 and 205 calls for a 15,000 square foot area to be excavated to 25" inches for unsuitable soil, and disposed of- Who is paying for this disposal, or is this going to the stockpile that school/town is keeping?

Answer: See answer to question #2 above.

9. Question: If Material is deemed inadequate after stripping of field, who is paying for the change in materials for fill/ soil?

Answer: See answer to #7 above. This only applies to additional material required outside of what is required in the "Lump Sum" bid.

10. Question: Where is the chain link fence to be installed? On plans all I can see is the 40' Jay pro Backstop

Answer: Backstop Only

11. Question: Are there dugouts being installed? All I see for concrete is the sidewalk in right field

Answer: No dugouts in this project
