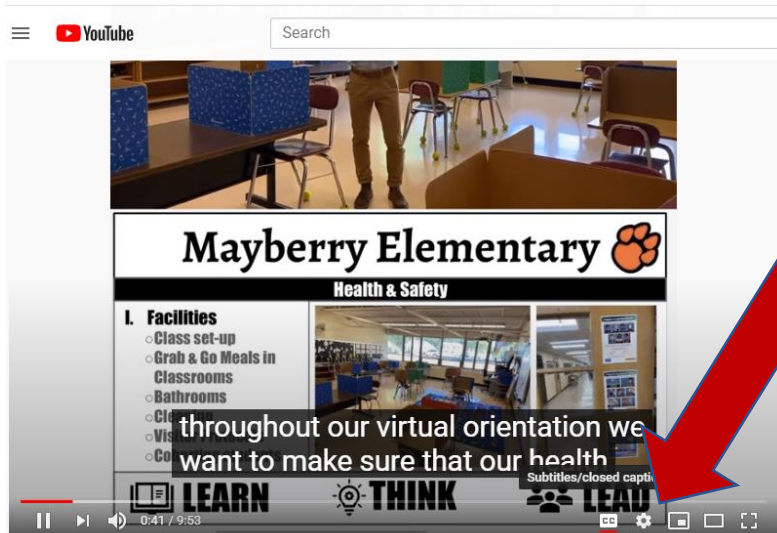


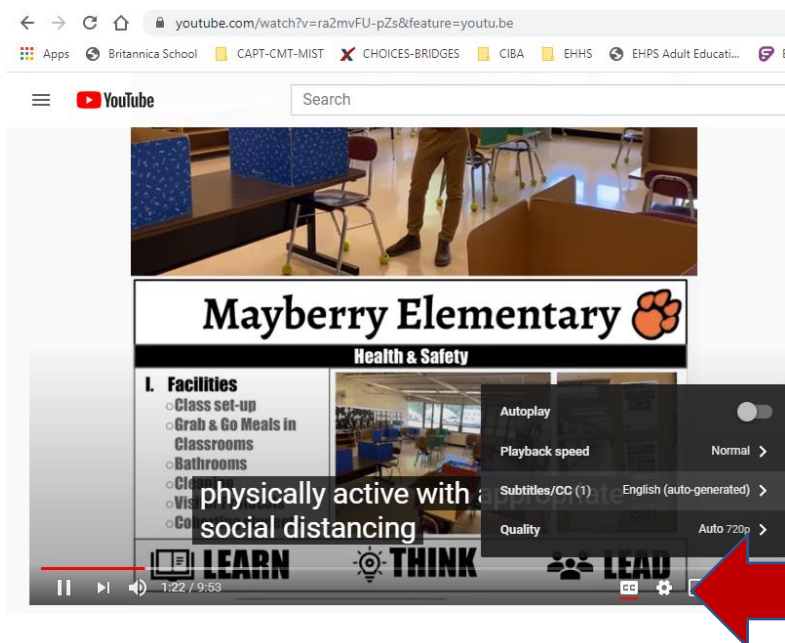


Adding Subtitles on YouTube // Añadiendo Subtítulos en YouTube

1. On the YouTube video, click on the CC button at the bottom of the video. This will turn on closed captions. // En el video de YouTube, haga clic en el botón CC en la parte inferior del video. Este enciende los subtítulos.
