The Board moved:

That the East Hartford Board of Education accept the stipulated agreement entered into between the Administration of the East Hartford Public Schools and the Parents of the Student who is the subject of this hearing. The student shall be expelled for one school calendar year from December 21, 2012 to December 21, 2013. However, the student may be permitted early readmission on July 1, 2013 if the Superintendent finds that the student has met the following conditions:

- 1. The student receives a 2.5 GPA in his alternative educational program which shall be held at the Stevens Alternative High School in the Synergy Program.**
- 2. The student avoids any serious disciplinary incident resulting in an ISS or OSS.**
- 3. The student has no more than 5 unexcused absences.**

If readmitted early, the student will be on probation for the remainder of the original expulsion period. During the probation period, the student must adhere to the three conditions set above. If the student violates the conditions of his probation as determined by the Superintendent, the Superintendent is authorized to reinstate the remaining term of the expulsion without further action by the Board.

If the student meets the conditions of this agreement, the expulsion shall be expunged from his records on or about December 21, 2013.

During the period of expulsion, he shall not be able to participate in school sponsored activities or be on school premises, with the exception of taking the bus to and from his alternative education program.
