## **Connections Activity**

Title/Skill:	Landmine
<b>Connection Goal:</b>	Personalization w/ emphasis on: Cooperation, Trust, Problem solving
Grade Level:	9-12
Month:	Any
Time Needed:	25 minutes

## **Handouts/Materials Provided:**

- Rope
- Foam blocks, paper, or anything flat that can be stepped on
- Blindfold

## **Summary of Activity for the Advisor:**

- Place rope on floor to establish boundaries of the mine field (square or circular shapes work).
- Gather students around the mine field and give each a foam block or paper. Then have students randomly place their "mines" inside of the rope. Designate a starting point and an exit (opposing diagonal corners work well)
- Once the mine field is arranged, explain the objective: each member of the group must successfully walk through the mine field blindfolded while being guided/directed by the group without stepping on a "mine". If a student steps on a "mine" they must start over again.

## Read/Review/Discuss/Do with students:

1. **Discuss:** What strategies were effective/ineffective? What was it like being blindfolded? What helped you follow directions? What made the activity/directions confusing?

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
