Title/Skill:	“It” Tag
Connection Goal:	Personalization
Grade Level:	9-10
Month:	
Time Needed:	25 minutes

Handouts/Materials Provided:
Masking Tape

Summary of Activity for the Advisor:

1. Mark boundaries for a large play area in which players can run and move.
2. Tell players to scatter around area. Every player is “it.” The goal is to be the last person standing. On your signal, players try to tag another player before being tagged themselves. Players can break a tag-tie with a quick round of “Rock, Paper, Scissors.”
3. If tagged, a player is out and kneels where he/she was tagged. The last “it” standing wins.

Read/Review/Discuss/Do with students:

- If 2 or more players tagged each other at the same time, how difficult or easy was it to resolve the issue?
- What helps you resolve conflicts peacefully with friends and family?
- What is an “it” you try to avoid in daily life?
