Title/Skill:	Who Are You?
Connection Goal:	Personalization
Grade Level:	9-12
Month:	
Time Needed:	25 minutes

Handouts/Materials Provided:

Summary of Activity for the Advisor:

1. Imagine you could ask someone you just met anything you wanted to know in order to learn something about them. What would you ask?
2. Ask the group to brainstorm a list of ten or so questions that people would like to ask each other. The questions should be appropriate for the setting, so monitor your group's choices.
3. Narrow the list down to two or three questions that people like best and write them on a white/black board. Allow whatever length or time you want for mingling and conversing. Encourage people to try to talk to everyone.

Read/Review/Discuss/Do with students:

- Examples of questions might be: What is the funniest situation you have encountered the last two months? What famous person, living or dead, would you most like to have dinner with?
